Funny Sock Day was a fun celebration of individuality, creativity, and school spirit.



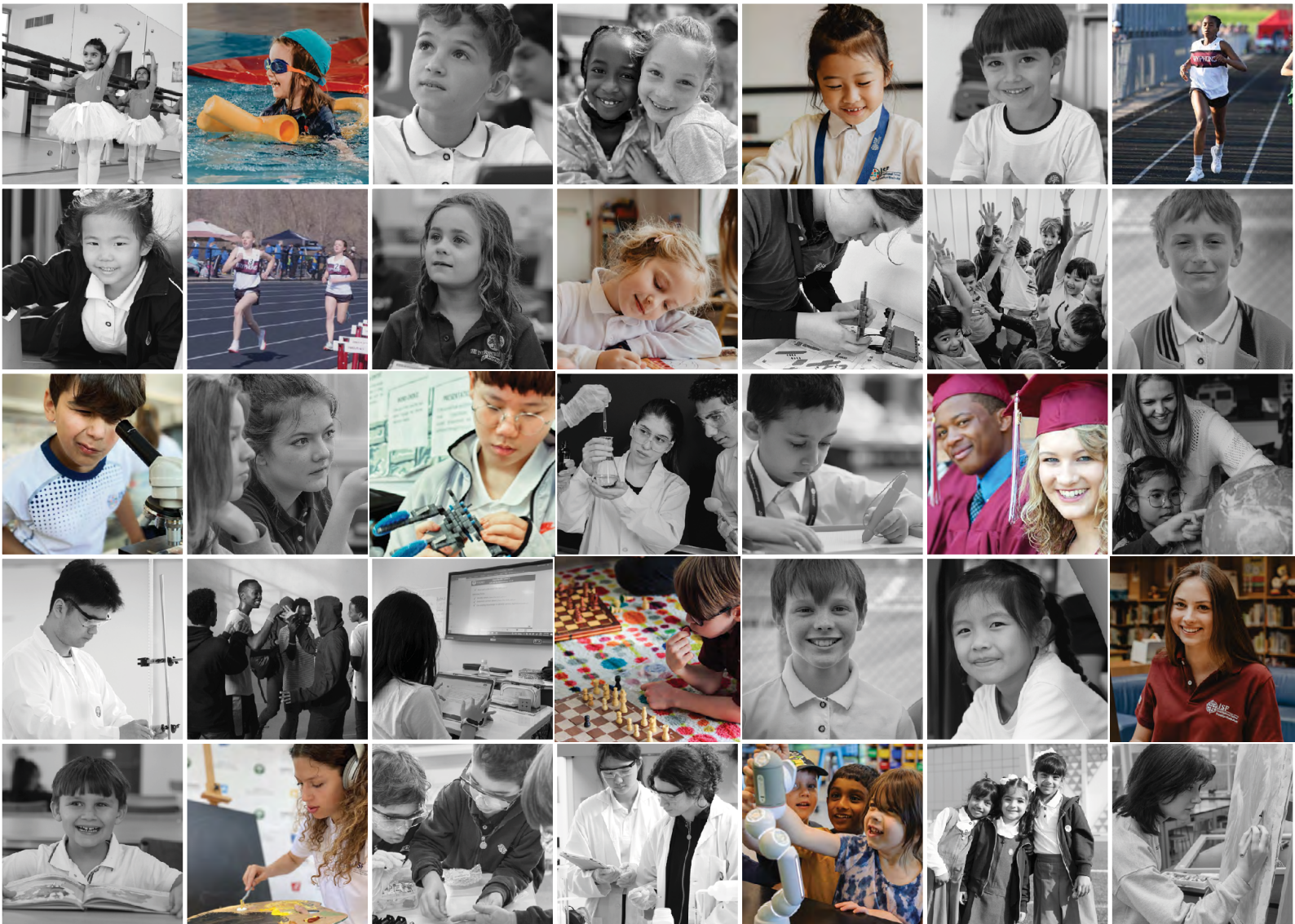
BIRDHOUSES

As part of our Reading Campaign, Grade 1 students explored a book about birdhouses and brought their learning to life by designing their own creative birdhouse models.



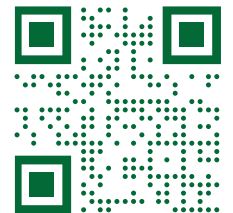
